


1. Add Zero Quantity to a Shopping List

Items (Carton and/or Units) can now be added to a new or existing shopping list with a zero quantity.

This will apply when adding an item from either the product data page (see below) or from an order form.


- Change the quantity to zero.
- Click on the **Add to Shopping List** link.
- Select the required shopping list (or create a new shopping list).
- Click on the Add to Shopping List.



You will be notified when the product has been successfully added - 'Product added to the Shopping List successfully'.



The selected shopping list now contains the added item but with a zero quantity (carton or unit).





2. Adding a Shopping List to the Basket (Zero Quantity)

When adding a shopping list to a basket, and the shopping list contains items with both quantities and zero quantities (cartons and/or units), only those items in a shopping list with a quantity displayed will be added to the basket.

Those items in a shopping list with a zero quantity will not be added to the basket.




3. Zero All Quantities (Shopping Lists)

A new **Zero All Quantities** button has been added to the shopping list page (located at both the top and bottom of the shopping list page).

The purpose of this button is to allow customers to reset (clear) any existing quantities in their shopping list to zero, and then update the items / quantities they require, before adding them to their basket.

Note: Using the **Zero All Quantities** button **will not** permanently reduce the quantities to zero. Once the customer leaves the Shopping List screen, and then returns, the item quantities will have reset to their original settings.

If the customer wants to permanently display their Shopping List items with zero quantities, once they have clicked on the **Zero All Quantities** button, they must also click on the **Save Changes** button.





4. My Basket (Add to Shopping List link)

The **Add to Shopping List** link displayed on the *My Basket* page is now located at the top of the basket.


The **Add to Shopping List** button has been removed from the bottom of the basket page.



5. Shopping List (Drag & Drop Function)


New 'Drag and Drop' functionality has been added to the **Shopping List** which allows items to be rearranged into a preferred order

In the example opposite, the **Peanut Butter** item is currently displayed as the **first item** in the shopping list.
